




### **Supporting the NHS in the COVID-19 emergency**

IHP is an integrated joint venture between two of the most stable and established names in the UK and international construction industry, VINCI Construction UK and Sir Robert McAlpine, IHP was formed in April 2003 specifically to focus on delivery of healthcare projects.

IHP is extremely proud to be playing a significant role in the sector's rapid response to the COVID-19 pandemic and the NHS need for expanded capacity to treat coronavirus patients.







In the first phase of the UK response IHP were quick to mobilise, working collaboratively under P22 with the NHS, the Army and our supply chain to successfully deliver the NHS Nightingale Hospital North West. Against a demanding fast-track timetable with 48 hours-notice and working 24/7 we transformed the Manchester Central Convention Complex into a new 750 bed hospital in 13 days.



The creation of the hospital, which covers 17,000m<sup>2</sup>, has been an excellent example of collaboration across all construction disciplines, with local government, the military, the NHS and our supply chain. It was officially opened on 17 April 2020 by the Health Secretary Matt Hancock and the Duchess of Cornwall.

Andy Burnham, Mayor of Greater Manchester, said: "Everyone involved in this fantastic facility are history makers and you will always have our respect and admiration for the sacrifices you are making to help our country through this crisis."

IHP went on to deliver a series of other COVID-19 emergency facilities.



For the 223-bed field hospital IHP used modular construction techniques to convert Bangor University's Sports Centre into a fully functioning coronavirus hospital in just 16 days.




## The Christie Hospital ICU (P22)

The IHP team made a promise to deliver this fast-track 26-bed Intensive Care Unit in under nine weeks and successfully delivered it in a record breaking 33 days, just five weeks.







These projects have been built to exceptionally quick timescales while ensuring delivery to the necessary quality and compliance requirements, and strict adherence to the COVID-19 site operating procedures.



#### P22 Project Management Office (PMO)

In addition to the Manchester Nightingale delivered by IHP the P22 PSCPs were also called upon to deliver 3 other Nightingale hospitals in Birmingham, Bristol and Harrogate.

The PCSPs quickly realised that a PMO was required to coordinate the combined NHSE+I and P22 response.

This PMO ensured that rapid contract documents were created along with standard briefs and designs, shared best practice, as well as

lessons learned. Working as part of the PMO also allowed for quick responses to supply chain and procurement challenges, providing overall programme risk management and system level mitigation with centralised reporting and assurance.



We also focused on adding social value. The VINCI UK Foundation has donated over £100k to 27 projects within VINCI Construction UK to help charities in the fight against COVID-19.

#### **Social Value**
