DIGITAL CONSTRUCTION

Perega is committed to modern design and management techniques. The use of technology provides efficiency in project delivery, seamless collaboration and inspiring and straightforward visuals for client understanding. Each of our offices has three-dimensional design and BIM capabilities.

We've been using Building Information Modelling (BIM) for over a decade. BIM allows for a more collaborative approach to building projects, as people can work together using common data in a shared environment which enables us to deliver efficiency for our clients. We have completed BIM stage Level 1 & 2 projects, including standalone 3D models, with in-house interoperability between design software, as well as full model collaboration with architectural disciplines, which has proved invaluable in clash detection and mitigation.

The use of Revit, integrated with our design analysis tool, has provided Perega with an extremely efficient methodology of model production. The BIM workflow involves creating and using an intelligent 3D model to inform and communicate project decisions. Our BIM protocols highlight the need for high standards which enhance design, visualisation, simulations and collaboration.
