UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL LLANDOUGH, SPINAL REHABILITATION UNIT

EAST SUSSEX HEALTHCARE NHS TRUST



£2m ward refurbishment at Eastbourne Hospital. Covid put extreme pressure on the Trust on capacity to treat patients in Nov/Dec'20. We accelerated works in order to provide additional bed space and handed over 6 beds early in December and the remaining 22 beds on 18th January 2021, 11 days early.
