The Interview

Your review will be treated as confidential by the Institute and the interviewers. However, it is your responsibility to obtain from your employer any clearance required under the Official Secrets Act or any other restriction placed on you by your employer. Whilst the Act and the need for commercial confidence will be respected by the interviewers, the interview panel will probe sufficiently to obtain satisfactory answers to demonstrate your general and specialist knowledge of water matters.

The panel will interview each applicant for approximately 90 minutes and will be based on the following:

- Presentation: Role of the Authorising Engineer.
- A minimum of 10 years relevant experience Operational Management and Statutory Management – your role and experience.
- Experience on other areas Risk assessment, Design and Spec of water systems, project management, water quality treatment.
- Other water related experience.
- Auditing experience
- Microbiology Water Sampling, Testing and Analytical skills.
- The ability to provide independent and impartial advice.
- Effective professional and interpersonal skills
- Why do you want to be registered as an AE(W) and what can you do to help IHEEM with improving the industry professional standards.
- Legal drives affecting the water safety environment.
